

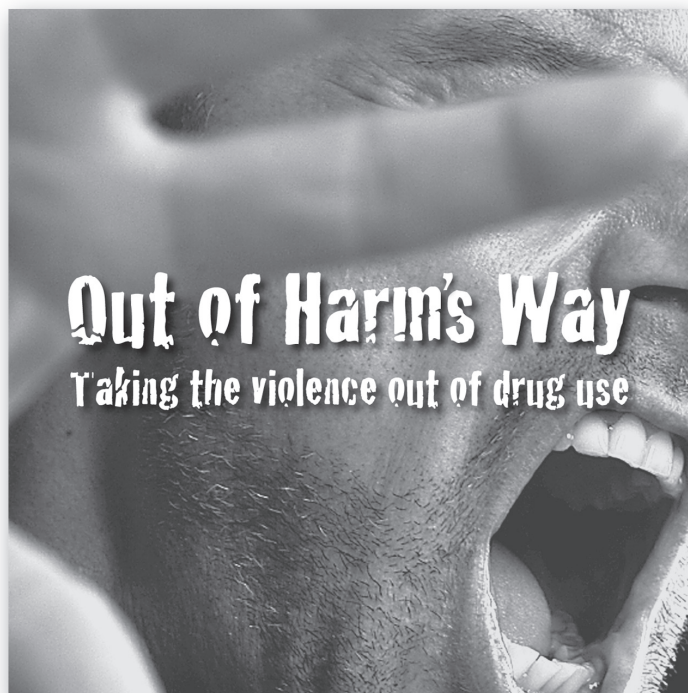

Although much of the recent attention relates to methamphetamine, the use of a range of drugs can lead to aggression or violent behaviour.
