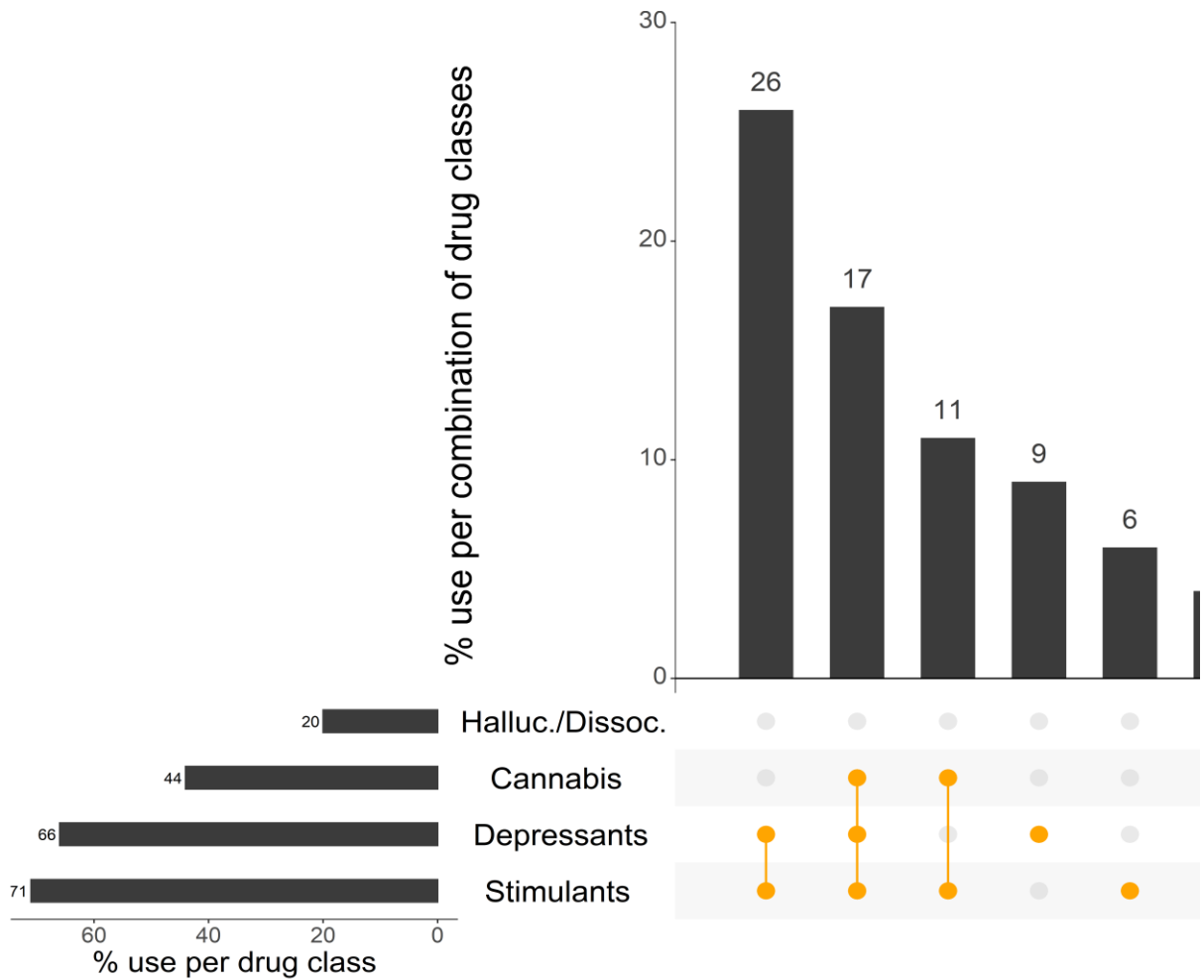


**Figure 39: Use of depressants, stimulants, cannabis, hallucinogens and dissociatives on the last occasion of ecstasy**

The bars represent the per cent of participants who reported use of each drug class on their last occasion of ecstasy or related drug use; the columns represent the per cent of participants who used the combination of drug classes represented by the orange circles. Participants who did not report use of any of the four drug classes depicted are not shown in the figure but are counted in the denominator. Halluc./Dissoc = hallucinogens/dissociatives (LSD, hallucinogenic mushrooms, amyl nitrite, DMT, ketamine and/or nitrous oxide); depressants (alcohol, GHB/GBL, 1,4-BD, kava, opioids and/or benzodiazepines); stimulants (cocaine, MDA, ecstasy, methamphetamine, OTC stimulants and/or pharmaceutical stimulants). Y axis reduced to 30% to improve visibility of trends.
